Jacqueline Kent, author of biography and non-fiction, most recently *The Making of Julia Gillard* and the biography of Hepzibah Menuhin;

Michael McKernan, historian and author with extensive experience in teaching and research, formerly Director of the Australian War Memorial, known for war histories, most recent book *The Valley*, a history of the small country community of Jugiong.
